

Anesthesia Cart Guideline

An anesthesia cart is a mobile cart designed to hold everything needed to support an anesthesiologist's preparation and administration of anesthesia. Anesthesia carts are designed for optimized movement and organized storage.



Anesthesia carts are an essential tool for anesthesiologists to perform their jobs efficiently in a hospital setting. The anesthesia cart's purpose is to work as a mobile unit in conjunction with the anesthesia machine. Anesthesia carts are unique due to their specific application.

- An anesthesia cart gives the anesthesiologist a worksurface next to the anesthesia
 machine's side and immediate access to the supplies they need when preparing to administer the anesthesia.
- Anesthesia carts are a great tool to help speed up administering anesthesia due to their high organization level. Most anesthesia carts come with dividers and other tools to help keep materials organized and separate.
- Another reason that providers turn to the use of Anesthesia carts is the security features. The anesthesia cart contains many
 expensive and potentially harmful drugs. Anesthesia carts provide different forms of locks, meeting double lock requirements, to
 keep narcotics protected. For added convenience, some carts have locking electronic features for immediate access with the use
 of an ID card.
- Monitoring features provide an added layer of security for anesthesia carts. Advanced touchpads include an electronic log option, that can be downloaded and accessed to track user and identify unauthorized access.
- Automatic locks are also often paired with electronic locking anesthesia carts due to the contents often stored inside of the cart.
 Guidelines call for an autolocking feature to secure medications, IV solutions, and needles/syringes. An automatic lock can help to ensure that the double-locked narcotics contained within the cart remain uncompromised. Automatic locks can be customized to lock after a certain amount of time to keep the cart double-locked without manually going in and relocking.

Who needs an Anesthesia Cart?

Any facility that performs surgery on patients that would require the use of anesthesia would benefit from an anesthesia cart. This would include hospitals, outpatient surgery centers, urgent care centers, and all centers where sedation is performed.
